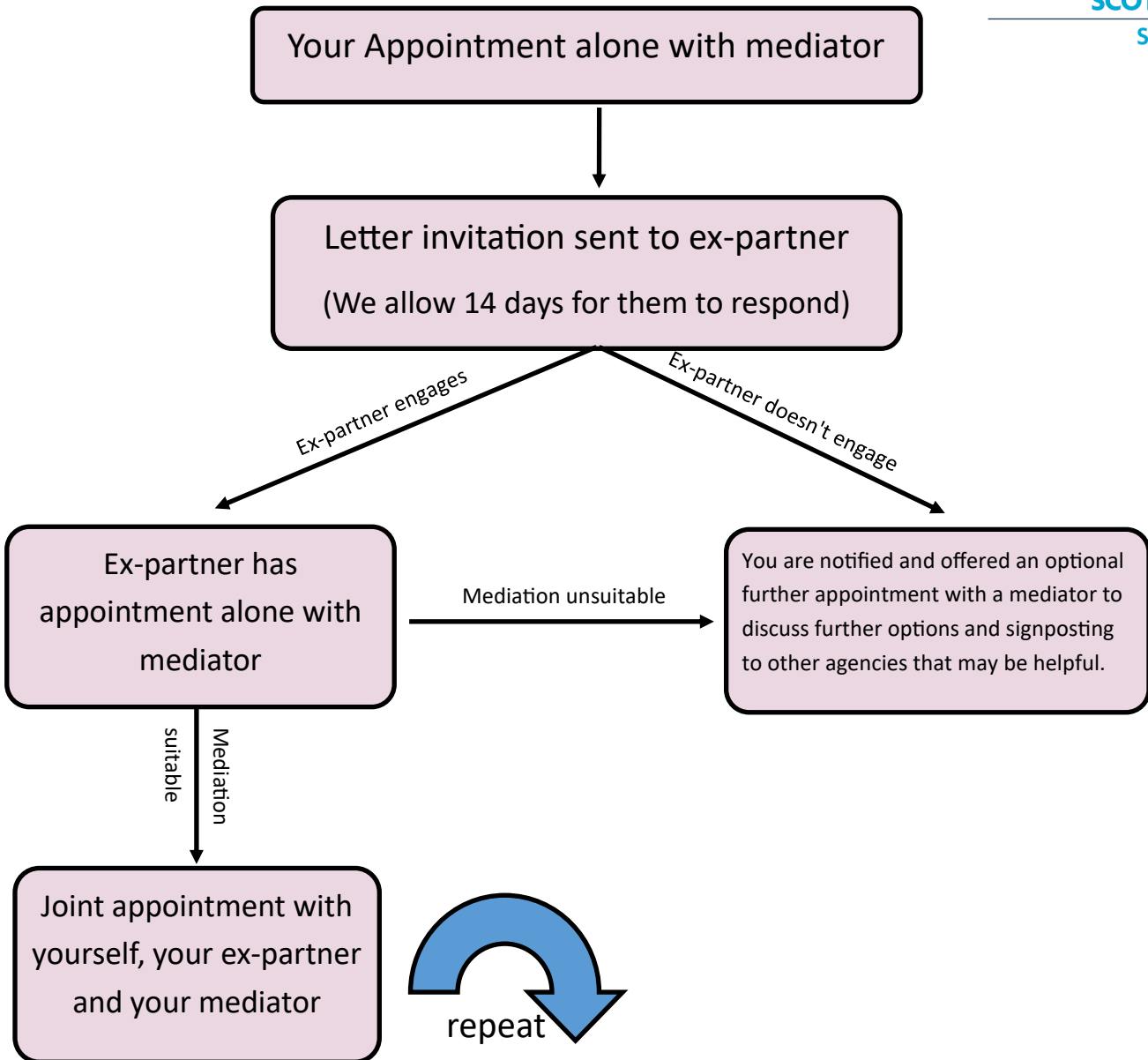


Your Mediation Journey



Following your mediation session you will both be sent a session summary letter summarizing your session and any agreements made. Your mediator will book your next mediation session so please be aware of any dates you cannot attend in advance.

A review questionnaire will be provided to you by your mediator in your 2nd or 3rd session to assess your progress. By filling this form in you help us review our service to ensure we are always working to the highest standard.

If you are unable to attend a session please give as much advanced notice as you can to allow us to rearrange this for you.

If either you or your ex-partner does not attend an appointment we will be in contact with you to arrange another appointment. If we cannot make contact with you within 14 days we will assume you do not wish to participate in mediation and we inform your ex-partner of this outcome.

Your mediation sessions will be supported until such time as you both feel confident in your joint agreements.

Mediation can end at any point in the process at the request of you or your ex-partner or the Family Mediator. It is the duty of the mediator to suspend or terminate mediation if they feel it is likely to cause harm to you, your ex-partner or your children.
